- **Traditional Poomsae Class:** For all belts and ages who do world Taekwondo poomsae
- **Sports Poomsae Class:** For more experienced competitors aged twelve years old and up Black belts who do world Taekwondo poomsae.
- **Para Poomsae Class:** For athletes with special needs of all belts and ages  
To build tournament experience and gain confidence  
Available only for individual event.

**Competition Rules:** Modified WT competition rules, modified USAT Junior Safety Rule for all Black Belts and Junior Black Belts only. For players aged 11 years old, the rules may vary upon the discretion of the tournament committee.

**Competitor Awards:** **POOMSAE, BREAKING & SPARRING players will be awarded a medal for 1st, 2nd & two 3rd place winners.**

**School Awards:** “Best Player Award”- Player who showcased extraordinary ability and with the highest approval rate from judges and referees.

**Mandatory Equipment:** WT approved Taekwondo Uniforms Black V-neck for Black Belts only and white V-neck for non-Black Belts. All sparring competitors must wear WT Approved headgear, red and blue reversible chest protector, forearm guard, fist gloves, shin and instep guard, groin cup and mouthpiece. Each competitor must provide his or her own equipment.

**Participants failing to wear their full protective gear will incur a deduction of -1 point for each violation throughout the entire match.**

- Open to all ages and belt level: Individual, Pairs and Team
- No gender restrictions in forming pairs or teams
- No age restrictions in forming of the pairs and teams
- All belt combinations are allowed in forming of the pairs and teams
- Pairs consists of only 2 members
- Teams can consist of 3 members
- Individual: must perform designated poomsae for your belt level
- Pairs/Team: Must perform designated poomsae based on level (Novice, Advanced, Black belt)

### Scoring:

Traditional Class: Scoring will be in the following order of importance:

- Individual: Presentation, Accuracy, TKD spirit
- Pair: Presentation, Accuracy, TKD Spirit, Synchronization, Teamwork
- Team: Presentation, Accuracy, TKD Spirit, Synchronization, Teamwork

- Only for Black Belt players aged 12 years old and up can register for Individual, Pairs and Team event
- Pair has to be a female and male athlete of the same age group
- Team will compose of only 3 members of the same gender, age group
- Must perform designated poomsae per round ( Semi-Final, Final)

### Scoring:

Sports Poomsae Class: Will follow WT standards and rules

### General Information:

- Each competitor may register up to a **maximum of 5 events**
- Individual Division will be separated into male and female competitors.
- If there are not enough registrants within one grouping (age, level, etc.), that group will be combined with another appropriate group closest to the level/age group.
- Correct AGE is calculated as follows: the year of the tournament (2023) minus your birth year no matter which month you were born in, i.e.  $2023 - 1971 = 52$
- Depending on the number of entries, they may be classified and grouped into a maximum of 4 players per group.

### **ALL PARTICIPANTS IN THE TRADITIONAL POOMSAE, OPEN AND PARA POOMSAE EVENTS WILL BE AWARDED WITH MEDALS!**

- Due to various belt systems used worldwide, coaches / athletes are expected to register in accordance to the respective poomsae prepared.
- If deemed necessary, the organizer reserves the right to change or modify tournament provisions not stated in the guidelines.





- ALL COMPETITORS are grouped based on belt level, age and performance category.

- Boards are \$4 each.

- For safety purposes, the organizing committee will only allow 1/4 inch Demonstration Boards for competitors ages 4 - 12 years old. 1/2 inch will be used for ages 13 & Up

- Scores will depend on the level of performance

- A perfect score is achieved if the boards are broken on the first attempt.

- GOLD: No mistake

- SILVER: 1 mistake

- BRONZE: 2 or more mistakes

#### SPARRING RULES

- ALL Sparring competitors must wear WT-approved Taekwondo Uniforms, Sparring Protective Equipments (Head Gear, Chest Guard, Arm Guards, Fist Gloves, Shin & In-step guard, Groin cap and Mouthpiece)
- Sparring Match is (best of three) **This means that the competitor who wins two out of three rounds is declared the overall winner of the match**, each will last up to 1 minute. Time may vary in every division.
- Competitors who will not be wearing complete protective gear will be defaulted but will be given 60 seconds grace period to complete the required safety gear.

#### SPARRING CATEGORY

##### **Class A - Full Contact Sparring**

- Black Belt ONLY (12 & Above)
- Junior Safety Rules / USAT Safety Rules
- Light Head Contact ONLY

##### **Class B - Amateur Sparring**

- No head contact
- Body Kicks ONLY
- ALL ages for Color Belts & Black Belts

#### SCORING / WARNING & PENALTY

##### **SCORING:**

1. Punch to the body - 1 point
2. Basic Kick to the body - 2 points
3. Spinning Kick to the body - 4 points
4. Light Kick to the head (for Class A) - 3 points
5. Spinning Light Kick to the head (for Class A) - 6 points

##### **GAMJEUNG: All penalty points will be added to the opponent ( 1 point each deduction )**

1. Holding
2. Falling down
3. Out of bounds
4. Intentionally kicking below the belt
5. Attacking a fallen opponent after the referee has given the command to break or stop
6. Severely injuring the opponent's face or neck with a fist attack
7. Severely injuring the opponent by unauthorized or malicious attack
8. Unsportsmanlike conduct

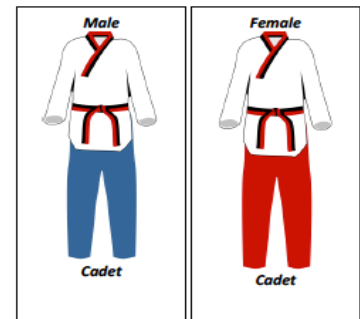

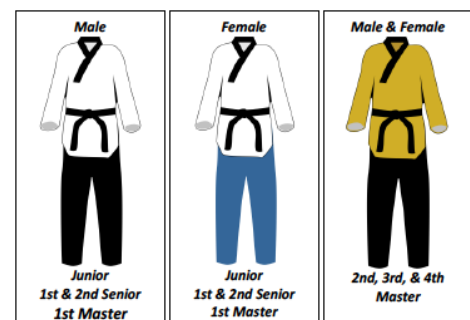
